Idaho Wine Consumer Survey

Draft Results

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Background

The survey received **405** responses using a Qualtrics survey panel between **October 18**, **2022** and **October 28**, **2022**. The completion rate is **100**% and the average duration was **6.7** minutes.

Limitations

- Survey sample overrepresents:
 - Women
 - Older respondents

Preliminary findings (strengths)

- More than 3 out of 4 agree that wineries
 - are good neighbors (81%)
 - play important economic role (79%)
 - promote tourism (78%)
 - positively impact quality of life (78%)
 - maintain open space and preserve agricultural land (77%)
 - provide cultural opportunities (77%)
 - protect land from development (75%)

Preliminary findings (strengths cont.)

- Most who have tasted Idaho wines agree it is
 - good quality (78%) and value (73%)
 - easy to find (74%)
 - appropriately priced (70%)
 - and compares favorably to wine from OR (54%), CA (53%), WA (51%)
- 86% are likely to recommend Idaho wines.
- 83% are likely to recommend visiting an Idaho winery.
- 76% are likely to purchase Idaho wines in the next year.

Preliminary findings (weaknesses)

- Most self-report they are only slightly/not aware of local wineries/vineyards.
- Majority guessed there are fewer wineries/vineyards than there really are.
- 49% have never visited an Idaho winery.

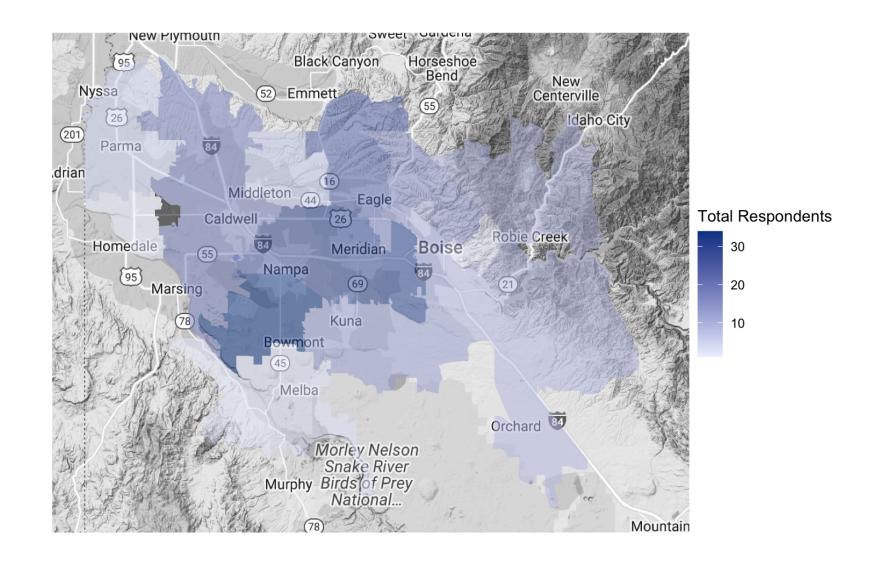
